INSTITUTIONAL AGREEMENT AND LICENSE

This agreement (the “Agreement”) is between the Licensor, Horizon Presentations (“Horizon”), and _____ (Institution) hereinafter “Licensee”. This Agreement is made effective by the signature of both parties on the date noted below.

The content of this Agreement is as follows:

1. SUBJECT MATTER

A. STUDY GROUPS

The content of this Agreement covers study group facilitator materials as described herein (the “Materials”), which shall remain the property of Horizon. The Licensee is permitted by Horizon to use the Materials for the specific purpose of facilitating study groups at the Licensee’s institution or place of business only for the International Association of Administrative Professionals’ (“IAAP’s”) Certified Administrative Professional® (“CAP”®) certification examinations. To enable the use of the Materials, Horizon will support the Licensee with necessary training materials and tools, including Action Plans, reference textbook, handouts, activities, Annotated Facilitator’s Guide, and other facilitator materials as may be developed for this purpose.

B. CREATIVE COMMONS FOLDER

Horizon grants the Licensee the limited right to adapt and/or create derivative works from the Materials for the sole and specific purpose of presenting the Materials to online, distance, or virtual (hereinafter “Virtual”) CAP study groups. Such adaptive or derivative materials shall be considered a “work made for hire” as defined by Copyright law to the extent that it is considered a work specially ordered or commissioned for use as a contribution to a collective work, the Creative Commons Folder.

Licensee agrees that all such works adapted or created by Licensee shall be added to the Creative Commons Folder after creation for use by all Licensees to enhance the educational process of preparing candidates for passing IAAP's CAP examination(s). Licensee further agrees to identify all materials added to the Creative Commons Folder as "prepared for IAAP and Horizon Presentations by _____ (Licensee)" the date of creation.

Licensee, IAAP, and Horizon agree that all Creative Commons Folder contents shall be freely shared with all Licensees of the Institutional Agreement for the facilitation/instruction of Virtual CAP study groups.

2. EXTENT OF LICENSE

2.1 Nonexclusive Right

The Licensee accepts a non-exclusive right in terms of conditions of this License Agreement to use the Materials and the Creative Commons Folder to facilitate **ONE** in-person, online, distance, or virtual CAP study group only and such right terminates as set forth below.

2.2 Territory

The licensed territory is Licensee's in-person CAP study group and/or Licensee's Virtual CAP study group, which may work across time, space, and organizational boundaries, but shall be defined by the purpose of preparing candidates to take the CAP examination at the next testing opportunity.

2.3 Improvements

Improvements by Licensee

All improvements to the Materials by the Licensee must be reported by the Licensee to Horizon for approval. Improvements in this sense include any advances which can be directly used or applied by the Materials and

which are copyrightable or patentable. Such improvements shall be considered a work made for hire and/or shall remain the property of Horizon.

Improvements/Additions/Contributions to the Creative Commons Folder

All improvements/Additions/Contributions to the Creative Commons Folder by the Licensee must be properly identified as set forth 1B above.

Improvements in this sense include any advances which can be directly used or applied by the Licensees in the facilitation/instruction of Virtual CAP study groups and which are copyrightable or patentable. Such improvements shall be considered a work made for hire and/or shall remain the property of Horizon.

Horizon makes no warranties whatsoever, neither expressed nor implied, with respect to any contents of the Creative Commons Folder. Licensees using the contents of the Creative Commons Folder accept all responsibilities as to merchantability, etc.

Improvements by Horizon

Horizon agrees to inform the Licensee about all improvements to the Materials. The Licensee has the right to be licensed to the respective new Materials by the conditions of this License Agreement with no additional consideration.

Horizon is under no obligation to make improvements to the Creative Commons Folder. Any and all improvements to the Creative Commons Folder shall be the responsibility of the Licensees.

2.4 Term

This License Agreement terminates on the date of the first CAP certification examination following the effective date below.

2.5 Extensions

Upon written request of Licensee, the terms and conditions of this License Agreement may be renewed for one additional term by Horizon with the approval of IAAP for a like fee arrangement provided Licensee makes payment of additional said fees as set forth below.

3. FEES

3.1 Fee

Licensee agrees to pay Horizon a nonrefundable license fee of \$500.00 plus \$15 (shipping & handling) for the right to use the Materials to facilitate **ONE** in-person **or ONE** Virtual CAP study group **only**. No other rights, continuations, or privileges are granted under this License Agreement. Licensee acknowledges that Horizon will share a portion of the fee with IAAP under a separate confidential agreement.

3.2 Continuations

Licensee agrees that the fees set forth herein are for **ONE** facilitated study group **only**. Fees for future study groups are solely determined by Horizon and IAAP and are subject to change. Horizon and IAAP agree to give advance notice of any future fee increases.

4. INFRINGEMENT

4.1 Distribution

Licensee agrees not to distribute, copy, or share the contents of the Materials electronically, in hard copy, or in any other way that is not specifically authorized by the Action Plan Guide without the explicit approval of Horizon.

Licensee agrees that the contents of the Creative Commons Folder are for the benefit of Licensee facilitators/instructors only and may not be distributed, copied, or shared with study group members except in the usual course and scope of the facilitation/instruction process.

4.2 Extensions

Licensee agrees to not use these Materials for any study group or purpose outside of this **ONE-time** License Agreement unless further fees are paid as described in §3 above.

4.3 Violations

Licensee agrees that any infringement of Horizon's Materials and or the Creative Commons Folder pursuant to this License Agreement are illegal and will be prosecuted.

5. GENERAL CONSIDERATIONS

5.1 Representations and Warranties

Horizon represents and warrants the Licensee:

- a. Horizon owns the Materials and its legal property rights, which gives Horizon the right to grant the respective license. Horizon possesses the contractual right to grant the License in case of improvements of the Materials. The Materials and its property rights are valid according to the knowledge of Horizon at the date of signature.
- b. While Horizon maintains ownership of the Creative Commons Folder, Horizon makes no representations and warranties as to the folder's contents or any warranty of merchantability to the Creative Commons Folder. Horizon's only representation is that it shall make the contents of the Creative Commons Folder available for sharing with all current Virtual Licensees.
- c. The use of the Materials is to be implemented pursuant to the knowledge of Horizon **without any exceptions**. The use of the Creative Commons Folder shall be open to all Virtual Licensees
- d. The Licensee has no liabilities or obligations to Horizon's Materials improvements. Licensee's obligations to the Creative Commons Folder are as described above.

- e. On the request from the Licensee, Horizon will provide the Licensee access to the Materials, training tools, and Creative Commons Folder as agreed upon in this License Agreement without further consideration.
- f. Horizon will inform the Licensee immediately in case legal changes affecting the Materials emerge.

5.2 Obligations

The Licensee will take all necessary steps to protect the proprietary information contained in these licensed Materials and keep the terms and Materials' content confidential. Licensee will take the appropriate steps to protect the proprietary information contained in the Creative Commons Folder and take all necessary steps to protect the integrity and maintain the merchantability of its contents.

6. GOVERNING LAW

This License Agreement will be interpreted and construed according to, and governed by, the laws of the state of Minnesota. Any dispute regarding this Agreement shall be examined under jurisdiction of these laws.
